Dressage Horse of the Year

Competitor Information

You can compete at all four qualifying competitions below, but you must compete at a minimum of **3 of the 4** events to be eligible for horse of the year; this applies to rider in every category. Riders who compete at all four events can gain more points. If an event runs over 2 days you will gain more points if you compete both days as points from both days will be counted. Freestyles are not eligible.

Please note: If you are lucky enough to win one of the categories you or your authorised representative must be present in competition attire at the final Margaret River event for presentations. Non-attendance risks forfeiting the award.

- Busselton 31st March
- Henty 25th & 26th May
- Bunbury 22nd September
- Margaret River 13th October - Final Presentations

You gain SWDHOTY points for **every test** you compete in at the four competitions if you place in the top six - must be same horse/rider combination to be eligible.

Horse of the Year points: First = 6 points - down to sixth = 1 point.

There must be at least 3 competitors in a competition class at an event for points to be awarded except at FEI level.

In the case of a tie accumulated percentages will be used to decide on the winner.

Each winner will receive a sash/ribbon and a Champions Rug. Each Reserve will also receive a sash/ribbon.

Horse of the year will be awarded as follows:
